

DECLARATION OF THE EVENT PARTICIPANT

1. I acknowledge the following information from the Organizer:

 - b. personal data provided by the Event Participant in this form or later during the Event, will be processed in order to organize and conduct the Event, publish the Participant's image on film materials and photos taken during the Event for information and own documentation purposes, Honorary Patrons, Partners and Event sponsors at www.nocnaukowcow.com.pl, www.polsl.pl, and in the social media of the Scientists' Night and other units of SUT, as well as for archiving and accountability purposes required by the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation,
 - c. The Organizer processes the indicated personal data on the basis of a legitimate interest, which is to enable the Participant of the Event to participate in it and to enable the Organizer to conduct it and archive documents, and in the event of consent - based on the Participant's consent,
 - d. persons whose personal data is processed by the Organizer, have the right to:
 - have access to their personal data,
 - request rectification of the data that is incorrect,
 - request deletion of data, when the data is not necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or after an objection to data processing, the data is processed unlawfully,

- request to limit data processing, when these persons question the correctness of the data, the processing is unlawful, and these persons object to the deletion of the data, the Organizer no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of processing, but they are needed by the subjects whom the data concerns to determine, investigate or defend claims, or when these persons have objected to the processing of data - until the administrator's overriding interests over the basis of such objection are established,
 - object to data processing - for reasons related to the special situation of persons whose data is processed.
2. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to enable the Organizer to conduct the Event.
 3. The Organizer does not process personal data of the Event Participant in a manner based solely on automated processing, including profiling.
