

Regulations of the Scientists' Night of the Silesian University of Technology 2020

General provisions

§1

1. The Scientists' Night of the Silesian University of Technology 2020, hereinafter referred to as "the Event", is a unique popular science event in Silesia that promotes science and its application in everyday life. The aim of the event is to encourage young people to constantly expand their knowledge, study science and humanities, and in the future to conduct research and work as a scientist. Moreover, the goal set by the Organizer is to promote SUT as an interdisciplinary unit open to all age groups of the society, and to encourage young people to study and work in the field of science.
2. The Regulations of the Scientists' Night of the Silesian University of Technology 2020, hereinafter referred to as the "Regulations", are addressed to all Participants who during the Event will be staying on the campuses of the Silesian University of Technology in Gliwice, Katowice and Zabrze.
3. The Regulations define the obligations and rights of the Event Participants in order to ensure the broadly understood security of the Event by defining the rules of behavior of the Participants at the Event.
4. The Event will take place on October 10, 2020 on the campuses of the Silesian University of Technology in Gliwice, Katowice and Zabrze.
5. The Participant of the Event is any person staying in the area where the Event is organized, hereinafter referred to as the "Participant".
6. Entering the Event area is tantamount to accepting the provisions of these Regulations. Failure to read the Regulations does not release the Participant from complying with its provisions.
7. The organizer of the Scientists' Night on behalf of the Silesian University of Technology is the Science Popularization Center, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer".

Duties and Rights of the Participants

§2

1. Admission to the university campus during the Event is free and is available to all persons, subject to point 8 of this paragraph.
2. Minors participate in the Event under the sole responsibility of the adults who care for them.
3. All Participants of the Event are required to behave in a manner that does not endanger the safety of other people, in particular to comply with health and safety regulations and the provisions of these Regulations.
4. It is forbidden to bring to the event area and possess by persons participating in it, in particular: weapons, ammunition or other dangerous items, explosives, pyrotechnic products, fire-hazardous materials, alcoholic beverages, intoxicants, psychotropic substances, and other such substances.
5. It is forbidden to bring any animals to the Event area, except for guide dogs and assistance dogs.
6. It is forbidden to conduct any commercial, profit-making, promotional, advertising or political agitation activities without the Organizer's permission.
7. It is strictly forbidden to consume alcohol and smoke at the Event area.
8. The following persons are not allowed to enter the Event area:
 - persons under the influence of alcohol, intoxicants, psychotropic drugs or other similar substances,
 - persons behaving aggressively, provocatively or in any other way posing a threat to public safety or order.
9. Moreover, it is prohibited to:
 - enter service rooms,
 - enter prohibited, marked and unmarked places, which threaten the health and life of the Participant,
 - throw any objects,
 - proclaim and display obscene, vulgar and racist slogans, which incite international, religious and social hostilities, etc.
10. It is forbidden to block or gridlock emergency exits and routes, access roads for emergency services, as well as other devices that are necessary in the case of a rescue or firefighting operation during the Event.
11. In the event of noticing a fire or other threat to life, health or property, the Event Participant should:
 - inform the show host about this fact without undue delay,

- avoid panic,
 - calmly leave the premises of the Event.
12. The Organizer reserves the right to remove any Participant who violates the rules of personal culture and prevents other people from proper and safe reception of the Event. The participant is obliged to comply with the rules of respect for public property, respect for greenery and not to litter the area.
 13. In the event of any disputes, not regulated by these regulations, the decisions are made by the Organizer or the person conducting the show.
 14. The Organizer is not responsible for items left or stolen during the Event and for accidents resulting from poor health or through the fault of the Participant.

Organization of the Scientists' Night of the Silesian University of Technology 2020 in the on-line version

§ 3

1. The Organizer reserves the right to change the form of the Event program from stationary to on-line in the event of a critical situation / e.g. epidemiological situation /.
2. In the situation referred to in § 3 sec. 1 the activities, on-line Events are conducted on electronic platforms indicated by the Organizer on the website www.nocnaukowcow.com.pl, and enabling the on-line Event to be carried out.
3. Detailed information, including the subject, date and activity hours of the online Event, is available at www.nocnaukowcow.com.pl.
4. The application for the participation in the program is made electronically by creating an account and / or registering an electronic form available at www.nocnaukowcow.com.pl.
5. After verification of the application form, the Center provides the Event Participant with an online link needed to participate in the online Event, and / if required / a password not later than on the day preceding the online Event.
6. The parent / legal guardian of minors is obliged to punctually log in to the on-line Event.

Account creation and registration of Participants

§4

1. The account creation by the Participant begins on September 1, 2020 / i.e. Tuesday / at 12.00
2. Participant registration for all events starts on September 30, 2020 / i.e. Wednesday / at 12.00.

3. The participant is obliged to register their participation via the website www.nocnaukowcow.com.pl, by creating an account and / or by registration. Using the forms, the Participant composes their "own Night", i.e. an individual program of the Scientists' Night.
4. The application form on the website www.nocnaukowcow.com.pl contains the Participant's data / name and surname, contact telephone number, e-mail, name of the school /, Participant's declaration regarding the processing of personal data along with the information on free use and dissemination of the Participant's image on film materials and photos during the Event for promotional and information purposes, to which each Participant agrees.
5. The Event may be attended by individuals and organized groups with a guardian, provided that an appropriate number of vacancies are available.
6. In the case of an organized group, please mark during the registration: organized group with the size of the group.
7. The Organizer does not accept applications sent by e-mail or telephone.
8. The application for the participation in the Event is tantamount to accepting these Regulations.
9. In the event of IT problems related to the applications of the Participant/s, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel the application and carry out another registration.
10. In the case referred to in § 3 point 9, the Organizer will inform by electronic means / e-mail, Facebook, website www.nocnaukowcow.com.pl about re-conducting the process of creating an account and registering at www.nocnaukowcow.com.pl.
11. Before entering the Event, the person conducting the show / activity confirms the prior registration of the Participant / s.

Final provisions

§ 5

1. The Organizer reserves the right to establish and change the course of the Event and the right to establish and change the content of the Event's program and time, including immediate termination of the Event, in the event of force majeure.
2. The Organizer is not responsible for the consequences of force majeure. Force majeure is an event beyond the control of the Organizer, which causes that the performance of obligations is impossible or may be considered impossible due to occurred circumstances. Force majeure is in particular: weather conditions, breakdowns or disruptions in the operation of devices supplying electricity.

The Organizer reserves the right to use and disseminate the Participant's image free of charge on film materials and photos taken during the Event for information and own documentation purposes, Honorary Patrons, Event Partners and Sponsors, to which each Event Participant agrees by their participation.
